Its production is aimed at strategic sectors such as Automotive; Heavy Vehicle; Lifts, forklifts, cranes, handling equipment; Wind Power; Electric Power; Railway; Machine Tools; Agricultural Machinery; Valves, Pumps, Turbines and Compressors; among others. The company exports a high percentage of its production to more than 11 countries, on three different continents, through flexible processes managed by professional teams very knowledgeable about the different needs of the involved sectors. The services offered by the company include the pattern design and construction, core production, moulding, melting, heating and surface treatments, as well as machining.
