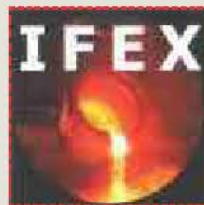
VENUE

During the Indian Foundry Congress, besides several other Important events, we will also organise **Cast Source Meet** which is equally important to producers and users of castings. **Cast Source Meet** is one of the star attractions for casting producers and users alike as it provides a unique platform for extremely useful Interaction and to understand and address issues of the casting producers and users. The event is of special interest to casting producers as they get exposure to new markets and challenges and to explore and prepare themselves for new markets and their needs.

The Cast Source Meets organised in the past during the 62nd IFC at Ahmedabad and 61st IFC at Kolkata were highly successful and speakers from leading Casting users such as Siemens, Tata Motors, Caterpillar, TAFE, Ingersoll Rand, EQL Ltd, USA, MES Inc USA, AVK Holdings Denmark, Skoda, Doosan Energy Industry Ohio, Audco, Alstom, SAAB Sweden, Buhler Industries, Canada, Brakes India, M&M representing a wide spectrum of user Industry Interacted with the casting producers and discussed their requirements and future needs and also held one to one discussions and generated serious business enquiries. Approximately 300 delegates participated in these events.

The cast source meet is planned on 27th, 28th Feb and 1st March 2015. There will be two sessions each of 90 minutes on 27th and 28th February 2015 and one session of 90 minutes on March 1, 2015.

IIF is inviting speakers from India and overseas to the Cast Source Meet from across various sectors using metal castings viz, auto sector, power, machinery manufacturers, railways, pumps, compressors, valves etc. etc. to interact with casting producers (Foundry units) in India.

This will provide unique forum for the casting producers and users to understand various issues of common

- ☆ Any other issue related to outsourcing of Metal castings and their recommendations to the industry to improve its competitiveness with regard to quality, capacity, consistency, value addition, response time for development of new components from prospective Buyers. **We assure you that it will be mutually rewarding experience and look forward to your active participation.**

Red Fort, Delhi



The Red Fort, was built by the fifth Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan, in 1648 and was the residence of the Mughal emperor of India for nearly 200 years, until 1857.

Jantar Mantar, New Delhi



The Jantar Mantar, built by Maharaja Jai Singh II in 1724, consists of 13 architectural & astronomy instruments was built for the purpose of predicting the times and movements of the sun, moon and planets.

Iron Pillar, Qutab Minar, Delhi



The Iron Pillar, dating back to 4th century A.D., was erected in honour of the Hindu god, Vishnu. The pillar highlights ancient India's metallurgy achievements. The pillar is made of 98 per cent wrought iron and has stood 1,600 years without rusting or decomposing.
